TERMS OF ISSUE

As a holder of a Restricted Area Vehicle Pass-Identity Marker, I understand the following:

- (a) That the Pass-Identity Marker issued to me is the property of the Billy Bishop Airport.
- (b) That the Pass-Identity Marker is not transferable and is only valid for the vehicle described on this application.
- (c) That the Pass-Identity Marker is only valid for the areas authorized when there is a required duty to perform.
- (d) That the Pass-Identity Marker must be mounted on the vehicle as directed by Ministry of Transport and be clearly visible at all times when the vehicle is in a Restricted Area.
- (e) That those vehicles issued with Ministry of Transport Registration Certificates or other identification documentation must carry such certificates of documentation in the vehicles at all times, unless exempted by the issuing authority because of vehicle design.
- (f) That those vehicles requiring annual registration and payment of fees, pursuant to the Airport Traffic Regulation, must register annually and pay such fees that are required, and obtain annual validation stickers. Validation stickers must be affixed to vehicle Pass-Identity markers as directed by Ministry of Transport and be clearly visible.
- (g) That I must remove the Pass-Identity Marker from the vehicle and surrender supporting certificates and documentation on demand of the issuing authority or a member of the Airport Security Staff.

RULES AND CONDITONS OF VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION ASSIGNMENT

1. The need and right to operate a vehicle on the manoeuvring area of a Transport Canada airport must be established to the satisfaction of the Airport Director before a vehicle identification for use in radiotelephone communication with ground control or a Flight Service Station may be issued.
2. The vehicle identification is assigned for use only at a Billy Bishop Airport :
The Sticker:
 - (a) is issued and controlled by the Airport Director;
 - (b) is not transferable between vehicles, except by the Airport Director;
 - (c) may not be added to or modified in any way;
 - (d) must be surrendered to the office of issue upon expiry, suspension, cancellation, or revocation of the assignment;
 - (e) may be revoked for failure to comply with (a) to (d).
