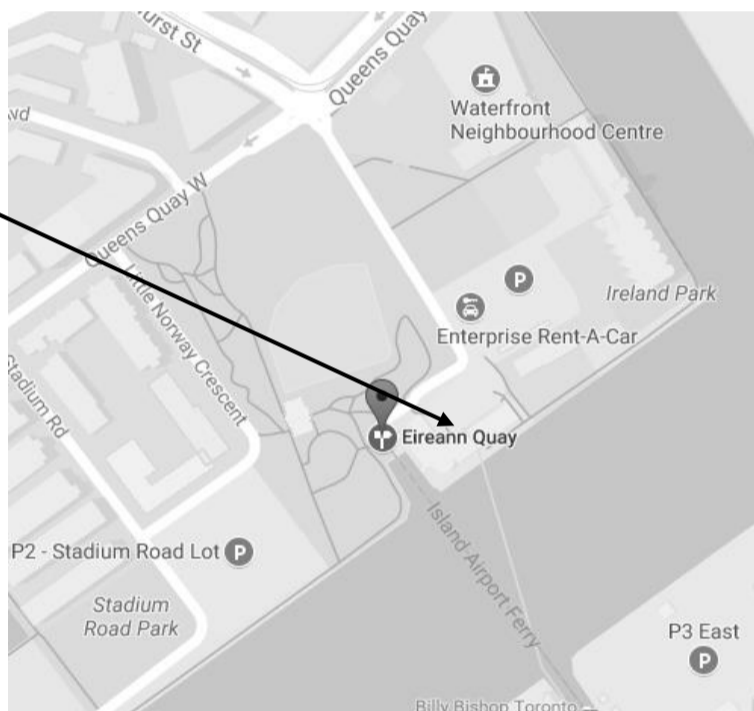
Watermain Repair Eireann Quay (Billy Bishop Airport)

Start Date: Monday, September 18
End Date: Friday, September 22
(Timeline is subject to change)

The City of Toronto will be undertaking emergency repairs to a watermain that is located directly in front of the entrance doors to Billy Bishop Airport (on the city-side). In order to complete the work as quickly as possible, in this busy area, the work has been scheduled for 24 hours each day during the five day period. The City is working closely with PortsToronto on these repairs.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- There will be jack hammering, saw cutting and excavation. You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Work Hours: The work hours will be 24 hours each day from Monday, September 18 to Friday September 22. This will help to ensure the work is completed as quickly as possible and to deal with any possible emerging construction issues. Every effort will be made to ensure no significant construction disturbances occur between approximately 9 p.m. and 8 a.m., for example, jack hammering, saw cutting, etc.
	Water Service Disruptions: There will be <u>no</u> water service disruption.
	Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, airport passengers and staff, and residents. Road users may experience some delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.



Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with asphalt following repairs. Final asphaltting is dependent upon there being no additional construction issues and is completed during dry weather.
