### Mark R. McQueen

*Chairman, Board of Directors, Toronto Port Authority*

## Deputy Mayor Norm Kelly

*City of Toronto*

Ward 40, Scarborough Agincourt Councillor Norm Kelly was appointed Deputy Mayor on August 20, 2013. He trained and studied Canadian political history at the University of Western Ontario (undergraduate) and Carleton and Queen's universities (post-graduate).

A trained historian, Norm Kelly spent two years researching two best-selling books in the field of Canadian History: *The National Dream* and *The Last Spike*. *The National Dream* won Canada's prestigious literary prize, the Governor General's Award, and was transferred to television by the CBC in an award-winning documentary series.

In 1973, Norm Kelly was appointed Chairman of the History Department at Canada's Upper Canada College (UCC). During his stay at UCC, he also served three successive terms in political office as an alderman on the Municipal Council of the then Borough of Scarborough. In 1980, he won a seat as a Liberal in the Federal House of Commons under the leadership of the Right Honourable Pierre Elliot Trudeau. Norm Kelly entered his real estate career after the Liberal Government left office in 1984. He returned to public office in 1994 as a Metro Councillor in Toronto. After amalgamation in 1997, he was re-elected successfully as a City Councillor and has been returned to office in every election since then.
