Dear Councillor Fletcher,

I am writing to advise you that from 7:00 p.m. on Friday, March 10 to late Sunday night, March 12, the Ship Channel Bridge will be closed to all traffic, including marine and vehicular as well as to pedestrians and cyclists. The closure is required in order to conduct important work on behalf of the City of Toronto needed to reinforce one of the bridge's critical structural components.

Over the March 10-12 weekend, vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be diverted via Commissioners Street, with clear signage indicating the diversion in place. The bridge will re-open late on Sunday night, March 12, and will be fully functional at this point.

In the event of poor weather conditions, the bridge closure will be rescheduled to the weekend of March 17 to 19, 2017.
