


Students are needed. This position would suit an individual who enjoys being in the outdoors and who enjoys being part of a team. It is a temporary position. Work is scheduled in shifts between the hours of 0700 – 2200 hours, consisting of full-time and part-time hours.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Cleaning and maintenance of washrooms and offices.
- Grounds-keeping including weeding flowerbeds, cutting lawns, picking up litter, emptying garbage and recycling containers.
- Fuelling of boats, pumping out holding tanks, and selling sundry items at the gas dock.
- Performing dock-walks to check vacancies of berths.

- Answering the telephone and in-person inquiries about the services provided by the Outer Harbour Marina.
- Providing a high-level of exceptional client service to our guests.
- Must comply with all PortsToronto policies and procedures including Health and Safety policies, SOPs, procedures, and legislated requirements.
- Must wear designated safety equipment/PPE as required.
- Any other duties that may be assigned by PortsToronto.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be currently enrolled full-time in a Post-Secondary Institution.
- Possession of G2 or higher Driver's License, must have own transportation to work location. Note that work location is not accessible by public transportation.
- Possession of a Valid First Aid Certificate and CPR Certification is an asset.
- Possession of CSA certified safety boots.
- Able to swim and tread water for 2 minutes is strongly recommended.
- Able to lift up to 25 Kgs (50 Lbs.) floor to waist.
- Fluency in English. Ability to communicate in French is a definite asset.
- Must be professional, neat in dress and appearance.
